1st Generation

Just after the German/French conflict of 1870/71 23 year old Heinrich Kentzler founded the company as a specialist roofing and ornamental metal work business.



Despite some difficult years for Germany the company has steadfastly grown over five generations.

Originally all companies had to join the Guild of Craftsmen. Following a change in working patterns, Heinrich Kentzler became Chairman of a "Free Union" which allowed companies the freedom of choice.

2nd Generation

Otto Kentzler took over the business from his father and began specializing

in copper roofs for churches, schools and other municipal buildings.



3rd Generation

In 1947 Otto Kentzler handed over the running of the company to his son Heinrich. The business thrived and the Kentzlers branched into aluminum roofing and fabricated the magnificent roof on the Westfalenhalle in 1952 and also the stainless steel covering for the planetarium in Bochum in 1963.

4th Generation

The present owner Otto Kentzler started working on the shop floor. He then attended Hannover Technical University where he gained his engineers diploma.

In 1978 he gained overall control of the company. In 1994 he became president of Dortmund's Chamber of Skilled Craftsmen and in 2005 he

became president of Germany's Confederation of Skilled Crafts.

5th Generation

Following in his father's footsteps, Heiko Kentzler also learned his craft on the shop floor before gaining a diploma in Business Management from Dortmund University. Since 2002 he has become joint manager.



The company depends on the skills and commitment of its 50 full time employees. To maintain its high standards the company has at least six trainees who they educate as first class metal fabricators and roofers. This gives an excellent skill base for the next generation and ensures future success.
